

How to Get Scuba Certified...

A scuba course consists of three parts: the classroom, the pool, and Open Water Dives. The classroom and pool run concurrently for a total of six sessions, either once a week or twice a week. This allows you time to read the textbook between sessions and to completely learn each new lesson. Scuba education is cumulative. Each new lesson builds on previous learning. To truly learn, time is required. Your certification is good for a lifetime and we will devote the time required for lifetime learning.

Your Open Water Dives will be conducted over two days. You may make these over a weekend here in Ohio or during most of our store scuba vacations. For the Ohio dives, we generally travel to the western part of the state and utilize what we consider the best quarries for scuba diving in Ohio. While it is true that closer quarries exist, we choose quality over convenience. For an extra hour's drive, your enjoyment will increase tenfold. Why learn to dive if it isn't fun?
